"Easy for St. Paul to Say. . ."

'I should like you to be free from all anxieties,' (1 Cor. 7:32) says St. Paul to us this Sunday.

'Anxiety is a fact of life, a very unhealthy state both body and soul. What is a Christian to do? Jesus said to Martha, 'you are anxious about many things – Mary has chosen the better portion and it will not be denied her.' (Lk 10:41-42)

Just what did Paul of Tarsus and Mary of Bethany do to dissipate life's anxieties? They listened to Jesus – *'Come to me all who find life weary and burdensome and I will refresh your spirit. Take my yoke and learn from me for I am meek and humble of heart and you will find rest for yourselves. For my yolk is easy, my burden light.'* (Mt 11:29-30) Get into the habit of talking to Jesus everyday. Invite Him into your heart, let Him stay awhile, feel refreshed! Maybe it is easy after all – like St. Paul says!

"Para San Pablo es fácil de decir..."

Este domingo, en la segunda lectura, San Pablo nos dice: *"Yo quisiera que ustedes vivieran sin preocupaciones"* (1Cor 7:32).

Las preocupaciones son parte de nuestra vida, un estado no saludable del cuerpo y del alma. Qué debe hacer un Cristiano? Jesús le dijo a Martha: *"Estás preocupada por muchas cosas, María ha escogido la mejor parte y yo no se la voy a quitar"* (Lc 10:41-42).

Qué hicieron Pablo de Tarso y Martha de Betania para disipar las preocupaciones de la vida? Ellos escucharon a Jesús: *"vengan a mi todos los que están cansados y agobiados y yo los aliviaré. Tomen mi yugo y aprendan de mí que soy manso y humilde de corazón; y hallarán descanso para sus almas. Porque mi yugo es suave y mi carga ligera"* (Mt 11:29-30). Deben adquirir el hábito o la costumbre de hablar con Jesús todos los días. Invítenlo a entrar en sus corazones y permítanle que se quede un rato y sientan su aliento. Posiblemente todo será más fácil, como lo dice San Pablo.

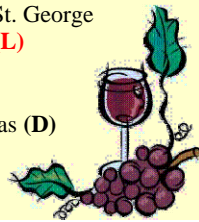
