"Candlemas Day - The 40th Day"

The Feast of The Presentation of the Lord has been celebrated in the church since the 4th century. Traditionally, candles are blessed and the faithful take them home to use for their own private devotions. Even though this feast recalled the presentation of the child, Jesus, in the temple of God, make no mistake about its Epiphany. Simeon is

promised that before he dies his eyes will see the light to the gentiles, the glory of Israel.

In the turmoil that is our world today, the light of Christ is so necessary in this time of darkness. The use of the number forty, whether it be years, months or days, in both testaments and in church tradition suggests figuratively at least, that an acceptable time has elapsed before some life changing event is to occur.

With the recent revelation that the U.S. Dept. of Health and Human Services will force all employers including Catholic providers to include sterilization, abortion inducing drugs and contraception in their coverage and services. The Light of Christ demands that **ALL CATHOLICS** protest this pending darkness, we should all march on Washington to let our light be known!!
