Although some of our plans were altered slightly due to the impact of the earthquake on January 12, because of your generosity and outpouring of support, our sister parish has been able to begin recovery and move forward with existing projects. In the aftermath of the devastation, we were able to send Fr. Abraham a check in the amount of \$5000 to assist in efforts concerning victims of the disaster. The funds were used to organize two mobile clinics in the area of Labruyere and to pay for the medical treatment of two young seminarians, Ganel Ambroise and Fresnel Alcima. A portion of the funds were also used for food, supplies, transportation, and contributions to a local poor Hospital of Milot.

And is now in use by the children of Labruyere. In addition, we have increased our monthly contribution for support of the education program to \$1,000 per month.


Dear friends,
